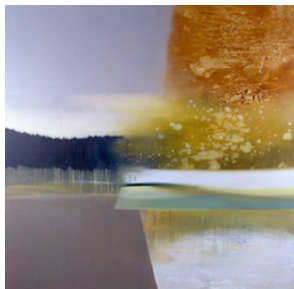


Two English Artists Hold Solo Exhibitions at Chelsea Art Gallery

PALO ALTO, California — This month, Chelsea Art Gallery continues to bring the best of British art to the Bay Area in the form of solo exhibitions by two of England's finest contemporary painters, Rebecca Campbell and Nicholas Jones. Through partnerships with some of London's top galleries, Chelsea Art uses digital technology to display a vast array of work available in the U.K. alongside actual works in the gallery. Visitors can expect to experience a new hybrid form of art viewership at Chelsea Art which gives them access to an unprecedented range of work.

November's exhibitions include Rebecca Campbell, *Up the Garden Path*, and Nicholas Jones, *Travelling Light*. *Up the Garden Path* is comprised of figurative works in oil, many of which take their content from well-known fables and proverbs. Campbell's attention to detail and charming sense of humor also shine in her illuminations of flora and garden compositions. Contrastingly, in *Travelling Light* Nicholas Jones explores abstracted landscapes in order to evoke a sense of place rather than depicting it naturalistically. The exhibitions open with a private view on Friday, November 4th. Champagne and canapés will be served, and complimentary valet parking will be available.
